






Joaquin Moraga Intermediate helps my child(ren) feel good about themselves.




Do you think JM is a safe place for your child to learn?




How serious of a problem do you believe acts of mistreatment are at JM?




If your child reported being mistreated at JM, where did the mistreatment occur? (check all that apply)




If your child is mistreated, which one of the following would most often describe how he or she was being mistreated at school? (check all that apply)




What advice would you offer your child if they are mistreated at school? (check all that apply)




Does your child feel comfortable reporting acts of mistreatment?







How often does your child report acts of mistreatment to you?




What do you think a parents' role should be in preventing or dealing with acts of mistreatment?
